SHOW COUNTDOWN CHECKLIST AND INFORMATION

We supply nearly everything that your children will need for costumes and hair accessories. However, there are a few things like socks and tights that you will need to supply yourselves.

Please see below and make sure that your child has everything required at all times in the theatre.

ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED

- Suitable plain coloured underwear. Students in a lot of numbers are recommended to wear flesh coloured bodies.
- Our finale will involve all pupils except our pre-primary pupils.

Finale: ALL FEMALE PUPILS (NOT PRE-Primary)

We will be providing sequined tops/dresses for all students.

We will also be providing heeled satin latin shoes for seniors

You need to provide denim shorts or jeans as listed on your costume list. White trainers or high tops

Finale: GRADUATES

Our graduate theme is pink and or white cocktail or long evening dresses with suitable shoes that you can walk down the steps in!

Finale: BOYS

We will provide the white sequined jumpers

You need to provide blue Denim jeans, white trainers/high tops as listed on your costume list

Hair and Makeup

Please arrive at the theatre with your hair and makeup done, with hairspray and lots of pins and grips. Bring your makeup for chaperone top ups.

HAIR AND MAKEUP

Pre-Primary girls

Hair- Centre Parting with 2 high bunches curled and with hair coloured elastic bands

Girl Dancers Aged 5-12 years

Hair- A mid height bun with a left side parting. Pony must be slick.

Hip Hop Girl Dancers-Pony Tail firmly held.

Make-up Girls-

Foundation, Bronzer or blush, Pink and Brown eyeshadows, Mascara, Red Lipstick.

Make-up Boys- Bronzer and brown eyeliner

Dancers Aged 12+

Hair- A mid height bun with a left side parting. Pony must be slick.

Make-Up- Foundation, Bronzer or blush, Pink and Brown eyeshadows, Eyeliner, Mascara, Dark red Lipstick. False Eyelashes.

Spray tans recommended.

Make-up Boys- Bronzer and brown eyeliner

Chaperones and Safety

We make sure that we have the legal amount of adults looking after the correct amount of children backstage. Our chaperones, which are not parents, are chaperone licensed by the council with full DBS checks (formally CRB), and many of our parents are licensed too. All teachers and theatre crew are DBS checked and are legally allowed to look after children.

All insurances are in place and risk assessments within the theatre are submitted way in advance.

On the first day in the theatre children will be informed of the fire safety procedure, chaperones informed of all medical notes that the children may have, and be shown the first aid and accident procedure. Children will be required to sign in and out with their chaperone at all times of the day.

All emergency contact details are on site.

Your children are in safe, experienced hands.
